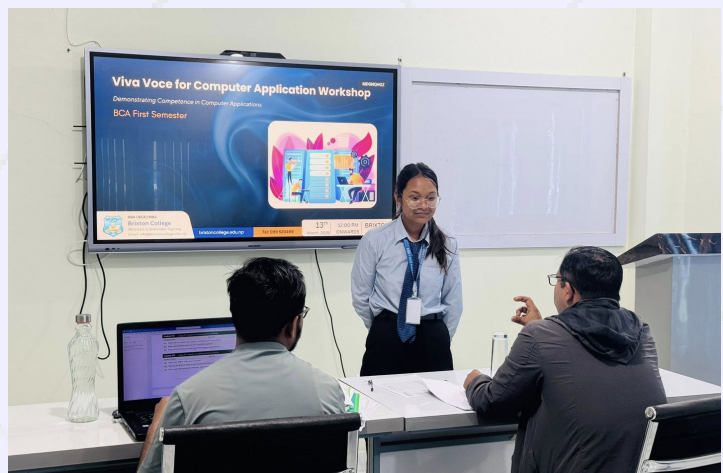
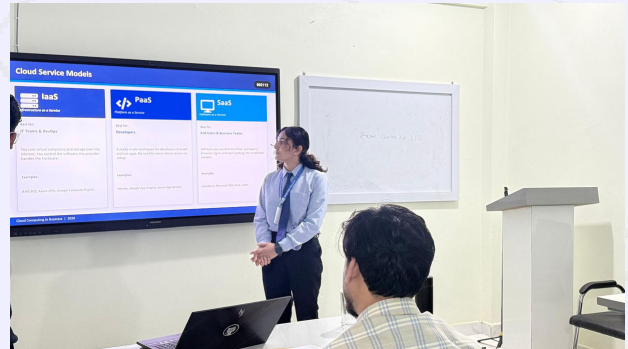
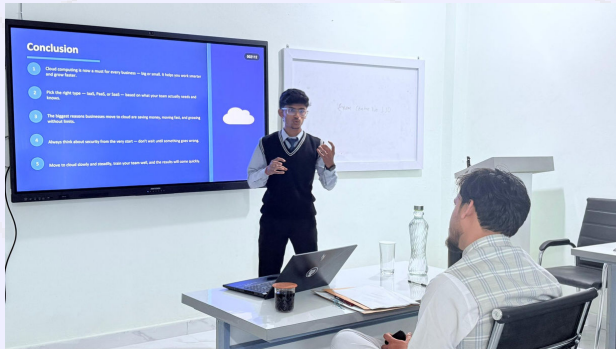

### Faculty Development Workshop on Research Tools Conducted

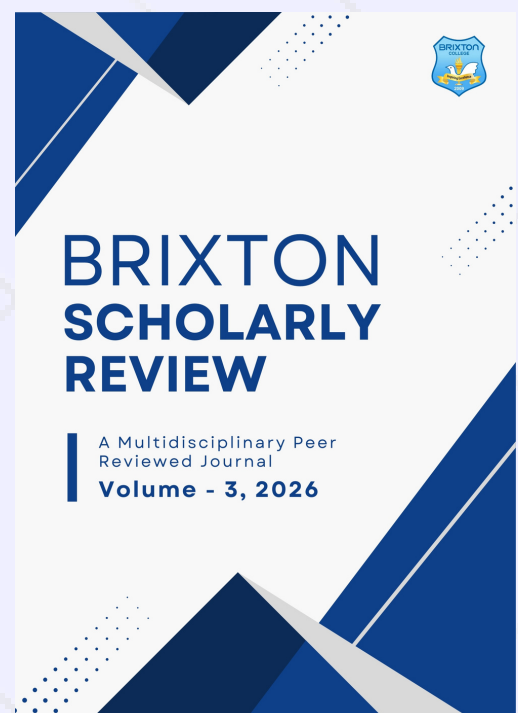

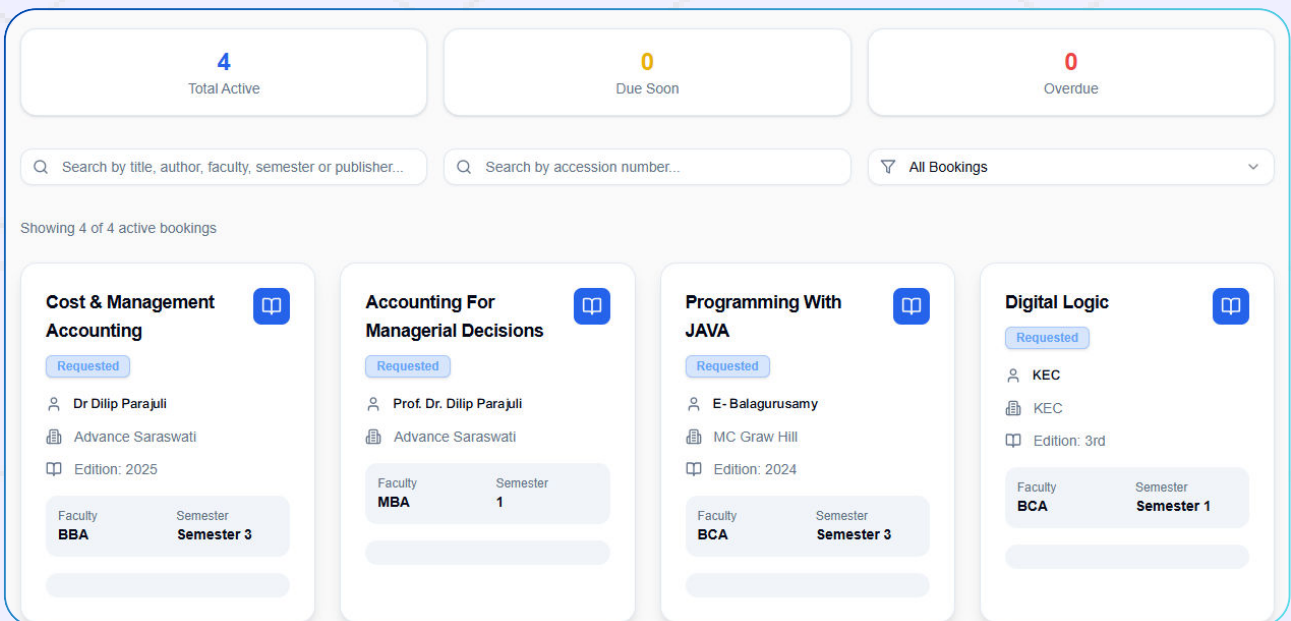

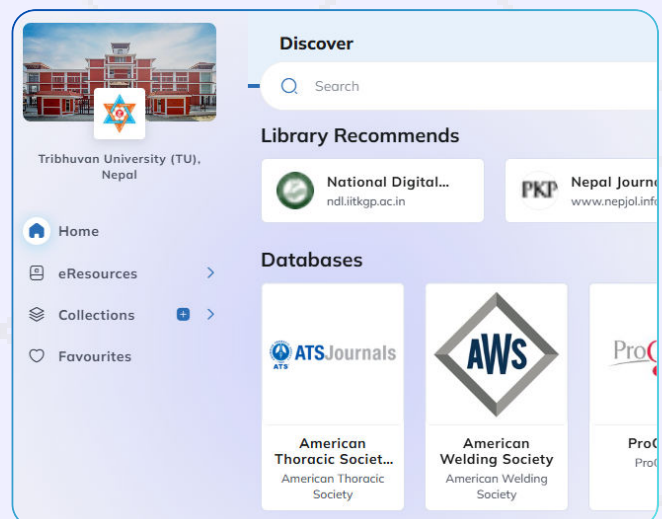
## Digital Library System Strengthened through EMIS Collaboration

In March 2026, Brixton College strengthened its existing Library Information System by linking it with the college’s Education Management Information System (EMIS). The updated system was introduced to make library services more accessible and organized for students. Through the improved system, students can check book availability, view library resources, and manage library-related activities more easily. The collaboration between the Library Information System and EMIS is expected to support better library management and promote digital learning practices across academic programs.



## Students Got Access to JSTOR and TU Central Library Databases

In March 2026, the Brixton College Library secured institutional access to JSTOR and the TU Central Library databases. Faculty members and students can now access peer-reviewed journals, international research articles, theses, and other academic resources through these platforms. The digital expansion is expected to support advanced coursework, data analysis projects, and evidence-based research within the BBA, BCA, and MBA programs.

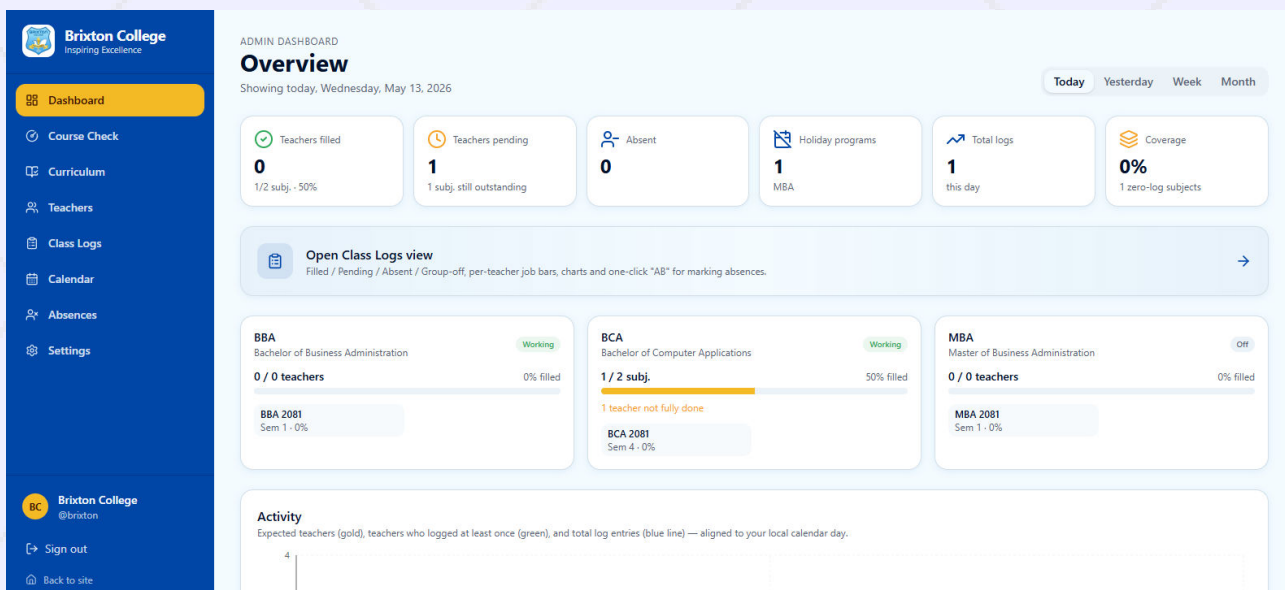

## IT Department Developed Digital Course Progress Tracking System

In April 2026, the IT Department of Brixton College developed an in-house Teacher’s Digital Course Progress Tracking System. The system was developed to help teachers record and monitor course progress in digital format. It supports better tracking of completed lessons, remaining course content, and academic progress. The system is expected to make course monitoring more organized and accessible. It also reflects the college’s effort to use digital tools for academic management.



## College Successfully Hosted Pokhara University Exams

On 17 April 2026 the Examination Department successfully completed the Pokhara University End Semester Examinations for Fall 2025 at Brixton College. The examinations were conducted from 15 March 2026 to 17 April 2026. Brixton College was selected by Pokhara University as an official examination center for the semester. The Examination Department managed the examination process smoothly. The role included maintaining the examination environment, supporting proper administration, and ensuring fair and secure examination procedures.

## Exam Question Paper Review Conducted

From 5–8 May 2026, Brixton College conducted an Exam Question Paper Review as part of its academic quality improvement process. The review focused on checking the clarity, structure, level, and relevance of examination questions. Faculty members reviewed the question papers to ensure that they matched the course content and learning objectives.

## Curriculum Review Conducted

From 5–8 May 2026, Brixton College conducted a Curriculum Review to assess the relevance and effectiveness of course content. The review focused on the structure of the curriculum, learning outcomes, subject coverage, and its connection with academic and professional needs. Faculty members discussed the strengths of the existing curriculum and areas that may need improvement, and submitted the feedback to the CDC of Pokhara University. The review helped the college reflect on teaching-learning practices and academic planning. It is expected to support better course delivery and improve the overall learning experience of students.

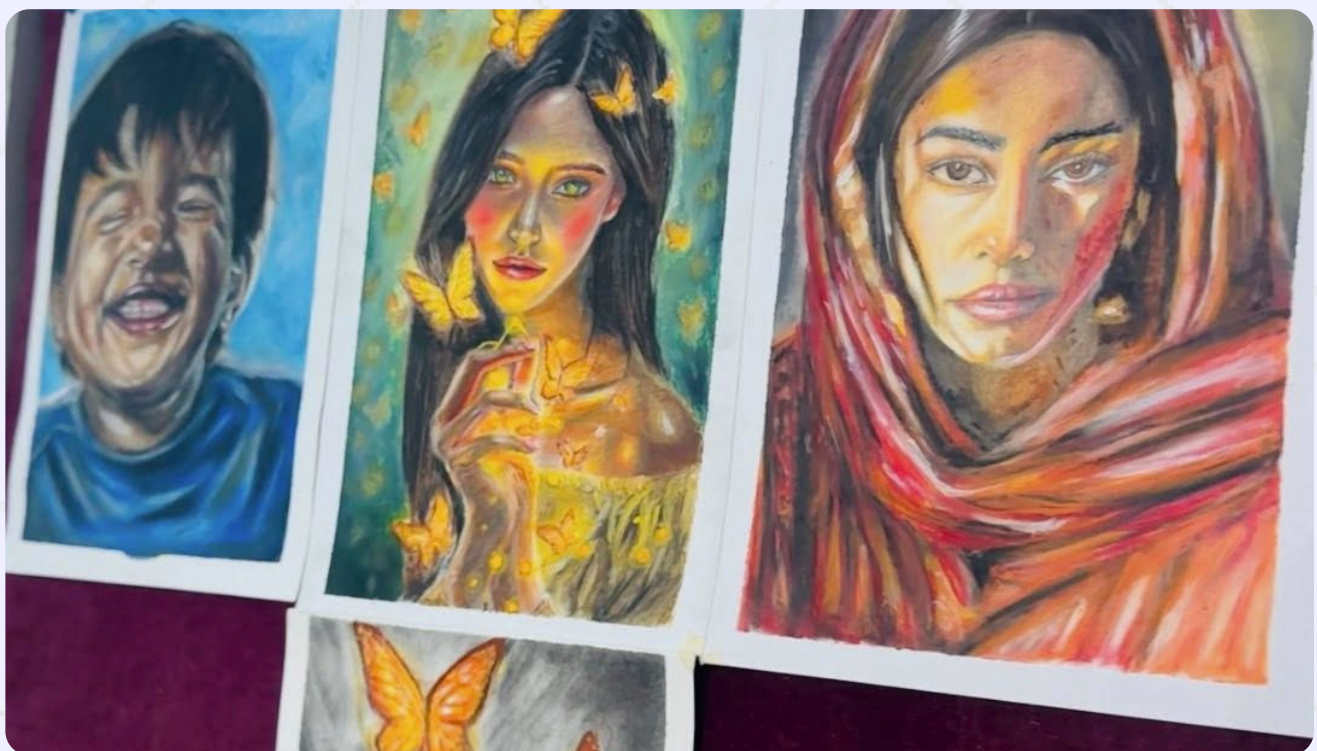
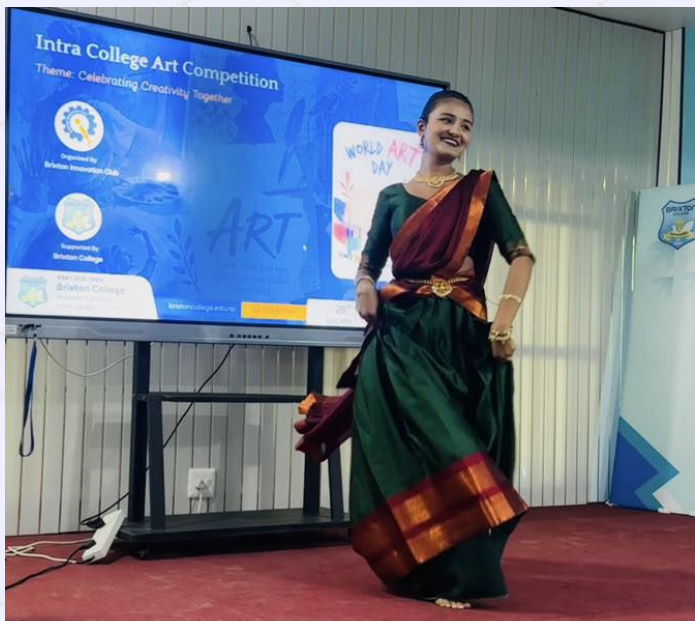

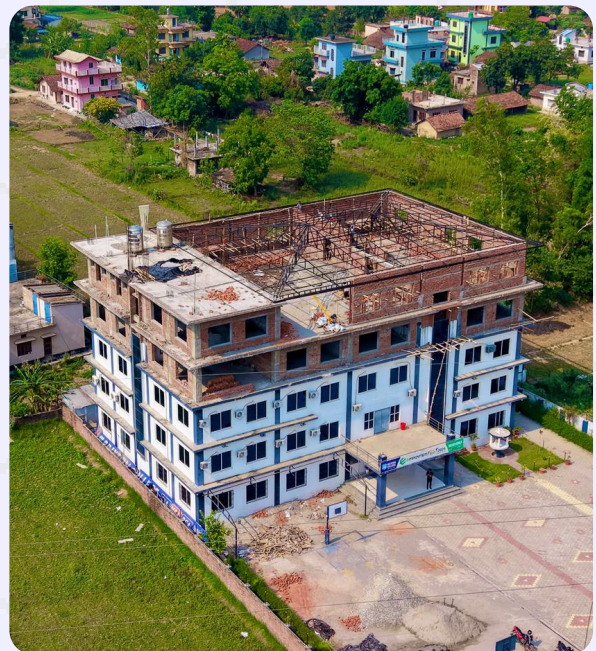
## Infrastructure & Construction News
